# Passport Etiquette

Your Arizona Wine Passport is a guide to discovering and enjoying Arizona's wine country. Here are a few tips to make the most of your journey:



**Appointments:** Some wineries require reservations, especially on weekends. Contact them in advance to secure your spot.



**Tasting Fees:** A tasting fee is common and usually includes a set of samples. Ask about fees in advance so there aren't any surprises.



**Sip & Savor:** Take your time to enjoy and appreciate each wine—it's not about quantity, it's about the experience.



**Respect the Environment:** Remember to dispose of trash properly and be mindful of the property when visiting wineries.



**Collect & Document:** Fill your passport with stamps, tickets, tasting notes, and photos to remember your trip.



# Tips for Wine Tasting

- 1. Stay hydrated.** A good rule of thumb is to drink plenty of water 1 day prior to your wine tasting adventures. Keep a bottle of water with you at all times. Sip water between tastings, and drink a full glass of water after each visit.



- 2. Eat a healthy, balanced meal before your wine tasting to prevent rapid intoxication.**

- 3. See, Swirl, Smell, Sip, Savor.** Hold the glass by the stem.

- 4. Rinse your glass with a small amount of wine, not water.**



- 5. Explore foods and wines outside of your comfort zone.** If you generally drink reds, order a flight of whites.

- 6. Get plenty of rest before your wine tasting adventures.** Sleep deprivation interferes with your taste buds.

- 7. Avoid perfumes and colognes on days you are wine tasting.**

- 8. Engage with staff.** Ask questions and learn what you can from each establishment. Ask for local food recommendations.

- 9. Plan for a designated driver, taxi, or ride share.**

- 10. Keep palate cleansers handy.** Bread, crackers, nuts

# Willcox AVA

— The Heart of Arizona Wine Country —



Located in the wide open valleys of southeastern Arizona, the Willcox American Viticultural Area (AVA) has become the agricultural center of the state's rapidly growing wine industry. Surrounded by mountain ranges and shaped by the rugged beauty of the high desert, this region produces the majority of Arizona's wine grapes and supplies fruit to wineries across the state.

The vineyards of Willcox sit at elevations ranging from 4,000 to nearly 5,000 feet, where warm sunshine during the day is balanced by cool desert evenings. This dramatic shift in temperature allows grapes to ripen slowly developing rich flavor while preserving the natural acidity that gives the region's wines their vibrant structure.

The soils of the valley are composed primarily of sandy loam mixed with limestone and gravel, providing excellent drainage for grapevines. Combined with the region's dry climate and abundant sunshine, these conditions create an environment where vines can thrive while producing grapes with remarkable concentration and character.

A diverse range of grape varieties flourish in the Willcox AVA. Among the most commonly grown are:

- Grenache • Syrah
- Mourvèdre • Tempranillo
- Cabernet Sauvignon
- Petit Verdot
- Viognier
- Malvasia Bianca



The vineyards here sit at elevations between 4,800 and 5,400 feet, where warm, sunny days and cool nights create the perfect balance for growing premium wine grapes. Volcanic soils, gravel loam, and limestone-rich earth give the region its distinctive mineral notes and bold fruit flavors.

Sonoita's remote location and small-town charm make it a favorite destination for wine lovers seeking authentic, handcrafted wines in a peaceful setting. Family-owned wineries, scenic tasting rooms, and breathtaking views make every visit memorable.

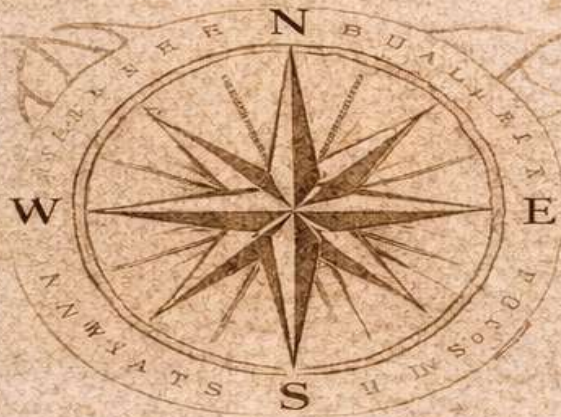

Arizona's Riverside Wine Destination



Set along the banks of the scenic Verde River and surrounded by the striking red rock cliffs of central Arizona, the Verde Valley American Viticultural Area (AVA) is the state's newest designated wine region. Drawing visitors from across the country, the Verde Valley has become a beloved destination for those seeking exceptional wines and stunning natural beauty.

Vineyards here thrive at elevations between 3,300 and 3,800 feet, benefiting from a moderate climate that combines warm days, cool nights, and the rippling waters of the Verde River. The diverse, mineral-rich soils found here—a mix of volcanic, limestone, and alluvial soil—create the perfect environment for growing a wide range of grape varieties in Arizona's high desert.

Old Town Cottonwood, the heart of the Verde Valley, is known for its tasting rooms, art galleries, and inviting restaurants. The nearby town of Camp Verde offers visitors a blend of history, equestrian events, and ancient dwellings built by the Sinagua people.
